The real question is whether we able to practice grace in making space for one another. Can we see faith and integrity in those we disagree with, and continue in relationship as siblings in Christ caught up in 'wonder, love, and praise'? As John Wesley put it, "Though we cannot think alike, may we not love alike? May we not be of one heart, though we are not of one opinion? Without all doubt, we may. Herein all the children of God may unite, notwithstanding these smaller differences." Blessing, Liam
